- Have received specialized graduate or post graduate level training in the subject taught in the program
- Have extensive experience to include no less than five years of practical application or research involving the subject taught in the course
- Social work ethics courses must be presented/developed or co-presented/co-developed by a licensed social worker in good standing

WORKSHOP FORMAT:

Workshops will take place in the morning and afternoon. Each session is limited to 1 hour and 15 minutes in length offering 1.25 continuing education units per session. Presentations may include up to three speakers, but one or two are preferred.
